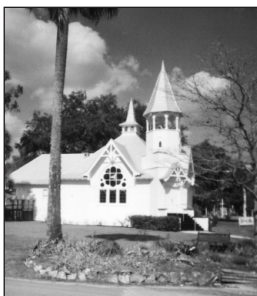

Gerri Redmond, librarian at FBC Lynn Haven gathered up over 100 Convention Press and Sunday School Board Press publications for our collection. The Sunday School Board started publishing books in 1894 and had published 32 titles before 1911. We now have 355 different titles from this 112 year printing project and add to the titles every week. We are especially in need of pre-1950 study course and Convention Press titles. It is our hope that we will soon have all of our 355 titles listed on our webpage so you will know which books we lack. Stay tuned to our webpage at floridabaptisthistory.org.

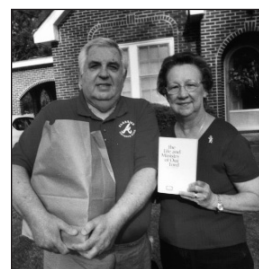
