## Evangelism

Here's Hope. Share Jesus Now is our theme for 1995 simultaneous revivals. Evangelism can no longer be just the pastor's responsibility. We churches and church members must work as a unit. The main thrust for our 1995 simultaneous revivals is to witness 60 times in 60 days. Starting January 9-March 9. We are praying that every one of our churches will have a harvest revival in April of 1995. The dates for these revivals are April

2-19. Our Association has chosen April 2-9.

Florida Baptist churches and missions baptized 30,047 in 1993. This was the fourth consecutive year that Florida Baptists have baptized over 30,000 people annually. Prior to this, Florida Baptists had baptized 30,000 only one time, 1980, in its history. The churches that report higher numbers in baptisms are majoring on personal soul-winning revival meetings and special events that attract the lost.

Another unusual event that has prompted many churches to baptize more people is the attention given to Intercessory prayer. I believe that God is honoring the prayers of our people for the lost.

The duties of the Program Committee are to work in cooperation with and receive regular reports from the appropriate institutional, agency or commission representatives in order to view the total work of the Florida Baptist State Convention; to assist institutions, agencies and commissions of the Convention in preparing program changes and to set goals and recommend allocations and methods of promotion of the Maguire State Mission Of-

fering. Thank you, for allowing me to serve Middle Florida Baptist in this work of outreach. If any church or an individual church member has a question concerning the Florida

Baptist Convention or one of its agencies please do not hesitate to contact me. I want to serve you in this work.

## Music Report 1993-94

This has been a year of great change in Florida Baptist Music with the retiring of Paul Bobbitt after 20 plus years of service and the hiring of Bob Burroughs as our new Director of Church Music. Charles E. "Blimp" Davis, Jr. has remained as the Associate and will be concentrating a lot of his attention to helping all of us "big" small churches in Florida.

Bob Burroughs has asked 26 people from every area of our state, representing all kinds of churches to serve as "The Director's Council" to give guidance and input in the goals of our music department. I was asked to serve in the area of small churches. We met in Jacksonville on September 8, for an inspirational two day meeting. Our new director is very inspiring and creative. Out of that meeting, we have been divided into 14 Florida Baptist Church Music Task Force. Five or six other people from over Florida are joining each committee to make a total of 90 people across our state. These are the people assigned with me: Haskell Dunn, Charles Lupkey, Roger Pursley, Peggy Earnest, and Wayne Blyler. PLEASE PRAY FOR US. We will be representing 72 percent of the churches in Florida who have under 100 average in Sunday School. All of the other members of the 26 with the exception of 2 or 3 are fulltime, paid ministers of music. Pastors, Music Leaders, let us hear from you if you have ANY suggestions on how we can help build up and train workers in our smaller churches. We want to

hear from you and pass this on to our Florida Music Leaders. They want to hear from you. God will hear and answer our prayers by showing us His Will I am sure. Across our state this year, we had a serious decrease in music enrollment reported and in Middle Florida we dropped from 993 to 967 last year and to 770 this year.

# Mayo Baptist Church History Highlights

## 100 Years of Ministry: 1894-1994

Early in 1894, 19 members of Half-Moon Lake Baptist Church with Rev. H. M. Frier as pastor, organized the Mayo Baptist Church, electing Dr. R. L. Goodbread, clerk. The same year the church was received into the Lafayette Baptist Association. Charter members included families of Wm. E. Bowman, Henry Koon, Rev. Zachariah Dees, J. C. Ramsey, Polk, Trammel and Scarborough. Rev. Zachariah Dees became pastor the following year. The initial building was built on a site given by W. T. Dees and wife January 14, 1898. This building was destroyed by a hurricane in 1898 and never rebuilt.

It appears from 1898 until June 18, 1909 Baptists worshipped in the Mayo Methodist Church on alternate Sundays. In 1905 the present building site was secured from the same donors and plans made for a building. On June 18, 1909 the new building was dedicated, free of debt. Rev. C.B. Cole was pastor one Sunday a month and served Perry three Sundays. During this eleven year interim, R.W. Phillips, R.F. Hacker, D.B. Harrell, W.L. Savage, and Rev. Dees served only one Sunday a month. The church withdrew from the Lafayette Baptist Association and united with the Middle Florida Baptist Association in late 1909.

Late in 1919 Rev. D.F. Barry from Madison accepted the pastorate now reporting 111 members. Two years later the first resident pastor was called, Rev. J.F. Russell, serving the church half time.

Seeking to have a full-time ministry, Rev. Julian Dyess was called in February 1940. Due to existing conditions it was necessary the Rev. Dyess divide his time with Hatch Bend Baptist Church.

It was in 1944 that the church attained its first membership of 200. During this year Rev. Horace C. Harvey of Cordele, Georgia was pastor and was succeeded by Rev. Mark Scarborough from Tennessee, who served just one year and was followed by Rev. Dave O. Alderman, former District 5 Missionary, who served a six-month interim period.

Sunday, September 30, 1962 the church had its Homecoming and the dedication of the new building. It was a memorable occasion with five former pastors present.

On December 4, 1977 the church celebrated J. D. and Irene Garden Day. J.D. served over 30 years as trustee and Irene served 38 years as treasurer. Rev. Robert A. Kelley, Sr. served as interim pastor twice (1976 & 1979).

Roy Lee Saint of Nashville, Tennessee was called as pastor in October 1979 and served until May 26, 1985. This being the second longest tenure of 5 years and 5 months with the Rev. S. V. Cofield having served the longest of 6 years and 11 months.

In September 1983 the church adopted a Constitution and Bylaws. Also, the church was informed by the Sunday School Board that it was the 25th church out of over 30,000 to receive the Church Study Course Awards in Doctrinal Study.

In May 1985, there were 267 church members, Sunday School enrollment totaled 140, with an average attendance of 81. Tithes and Offerings received ending 1984 were \$98,889.35. There were 21 baptisms reported.

The church voted to appoint a long range planning committee for future growth, October 1989. Those appointed were John Hewitt, Bland Lewis, W.G. Croft, Jr., and Darothy Millay. Five acres of land located on the East side on Highway 51 North was purchased from Jessie Mullis on June 13, 1990, total price \$30,000.

The growing need to minister to our youth led our church to seek a full-time Minister of Youth and Music in August 1990. A change in the Bylaws to cover the full-time Minister of Youth and Music was adopted on December 5, 1990. In June 1991, Francene Folsom resigned as Music Director and Cheryl Harris was elected to fill this position on August 15, 1991. The year end church membership total was 288 with 185 resident members.

In April 1992 a 18-passenger Econoline van was purchased and a bus ministry to Dowling

Park Retirement Center was begun on July 12, 1992. At the close of the 1991-92 year the church membership was 285 with 167 resident members.

Rev. Donald P. Moore became pastor in October 1992. The church participated in the World Mission Conference February 11-14, 1993. The Youth attended "Centrifuge 93" at Ridgecrest in North Carolina during July 1993. Membership at the end of 1992-93 was 293 with 182 resident members.

The Fellowship Hall was converted into five Sunday School rooms in October 1993. In November 1993 a cash gift of \$1800 was given

to purchase a computer for the church office was accepted.

January 1994 the church voted to hire an architect and Civil Engineer, activated the Building, Finance and Publicity Committees. Loyd Ezell was elected as Building Site Superintendent, and Curtis Goodwin as Assistant Superintendent.

In June 1994 Marinda F. Goodwin was elected to serve as a messenger to the Southern Baptist Convention held in Orlando, Florida. The year-end membership for 1993-94 was 289 with 176 residents and 113 non-resident members.

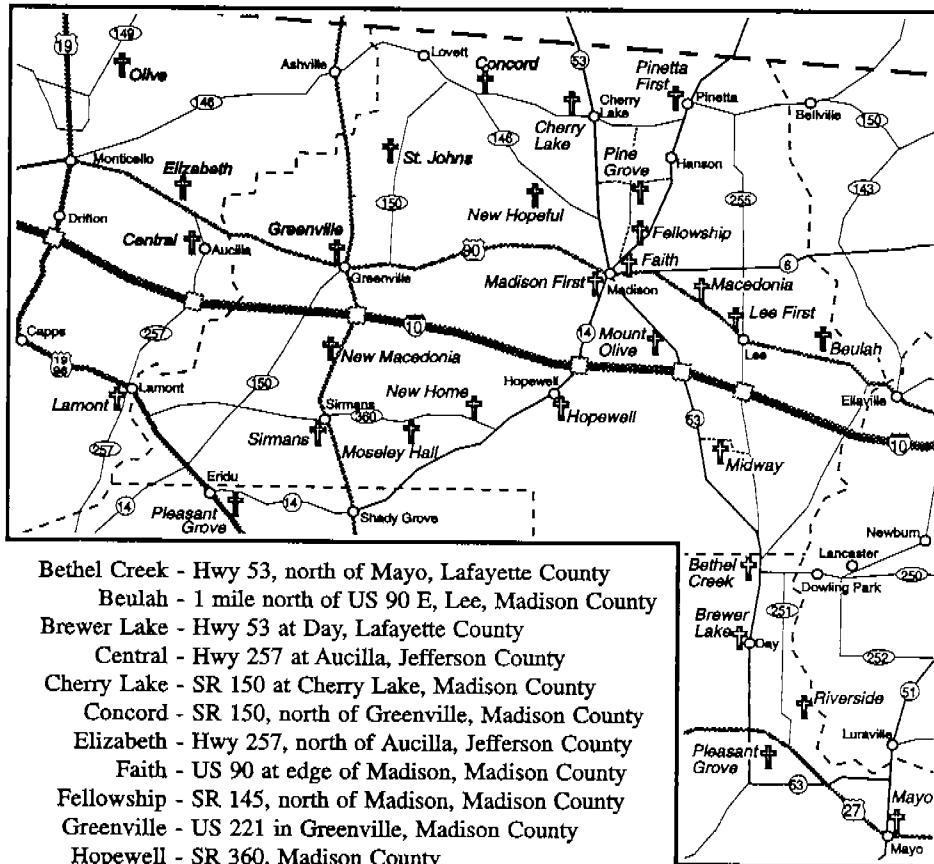
