The correct answer was: Andy Anderson. Anderson (1927-2001) was a native of Cherow, South Carolina and served as pastor of Riverside Baptist Church in Ft. Myers from 1955 to 1975. Judy and Lawson Jolly actually had Sunday School conferences with Andy; Joe Butler also knew the correct answer and John Hannigan heard Andy speak in Huntington, Indiana shortly before the death of Anderson in 2001.
