Dear Board Members and Friends of FBHS,

There are times that any organization needs to just stop and say thank you to some very special people for their particular thoughtfulness and kindness.

Jeff Pike thank you. Jeff serves in Huntsville, Alabama but was aware of our desire to acquire some Angel Martinez audio tapes. Angel Martinez (1922-1995) held more church revival meetings than any other Southern Baptist who ever lived. He preached in nine revival meetings at FBC Jacksonville, five at FBC Dallas and five at Belleview. Angel and his brother Homer are in the SBC Evangelists Hall of Fame. We are fortunate to have these sermon tapes of an evangelist who preached in scores of churches in Florida.

Dr. Bill Gray thank you. Dr. Bill Gray is the son of Rufus Gray (1915-1942) our Florida Southern Baptist missionary who was killed by the Japanese by waterboarding in an internment camp in World War II. Dr. Bill Gray is a psychiatrist and has a residence in Asheville, NC. Dr. Gray donated hundreds of items to the Florida Baptist Historical Society that related to the life and ministry of Rufus Gray.

Virginia Love thank you. Virginia is the daughter of William Cowherd and Marian Peeler Gray Cowherd. Marian was the wife of Rufus Gray and mother of Bill Gray. After WWII Marian married Charles Cowherd and Virginia was born of this marriage. Virginia is a practicing attorney in Chattanooga, Tennessee and has donated hundreds of letters and many pictures and artifacts from the service life of her mother Marian Peeler Gray Cowherd.
