Dear Board Members and Friends of FBHS,

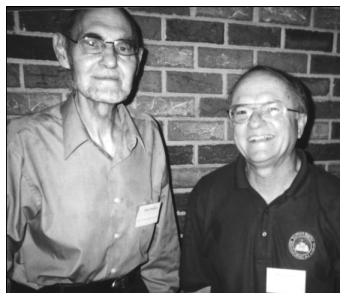
In our work there is always much to be thankful for in matters of vocation, location and celebration. It's good news to see people called to the ministry, working in a local church and enjoying their time of service.
