

## ***IN MEMORY OF HAWLEY E. RIDENOUR JR.***

Hawley E. Ridenour Jr., 74, died Aug. 1, 1983, in Jackson Hospital, Marianna, after a brief illness. Wayne Burdeshaw, Providence Baptist Church, Grand Ridge, officiated at funeral services at Brazeman-Neal Chapel, Marianna, and at Evergreen Cemetery, Gainesville, on Aug. 4.

Mr. Ridenour served the Florida Baptist Convention as an associate Training Union director with O. K. Radford from 1939 to 1960. Since that time he has resided in Marianna and has served area churches, resigning his last pastorate, Compass Lake Fellowship Church, September 1982.

A graduate of the University of Florida, Gainesville, in 1934, he received a masters in theology at Southern Baptist Theological Seminary, Louisville, Ky., in 1937.

MARIANNA — The Rev. Hawley E. Ridenour Jr., 74, of Marianna, died August 1 in Jackson Hospital in Marianna.

Services were held Thursday in Branaman Neal Funeral Home in Marianna. Burial followed in Evergreen Cemetery in Gainesville.

He was a native of Louisville, Ky., and had lived in Marianna for 44 years. Before resigning in 1968, he had been with the Florida Baptist Convention for 20 years as associate training union director.
