LEADERSHIP: The **Rev. Dean Reule**, 37, founded the church in 1997. He has a doctorate in humanities/religious studies from Florida State University, Tallahassee, a master's degree in theology/American church history from Princeton University, Princeton, N.J., a seminary degree from Southwestern Baptist Theological Seminary, Fort Worth, Texas, and a bachelor's degree in religious studies from Columbia International University, Columbia, S.C. He knew he had a calling to the ministry shortly after converting to Christianity at 19. He has been married 13 years to Hettie. They have two daughters, Annegrace, 6,

SERVICES AND PROGRAMS: The church offers a 10 a.m. Sunday worship service, with simultaneous services for children and youths. It also offers weekly Bible studies and youth meetings and monthly men's and women's ministries.

HISTORY: The church started in 1997 as a Bible study out of parishioners' homes and space leased from other churches. Its grand opening in its current location, a former model home center at Hunter's Green, was May 17, 1998.

RECENT SERMON, TOPIC OR THEME: Dr. Ruth versus God, part of a series on marriage.

MEMBERSHIP: Average Sunday attendance of 125.

OUTREACH TO THE COMMUNITY: It provides seminars for parents and families in an effort to build strong children and families. It also has sponsored a women's seminar on stress management.

NOTABLE: "We're a church that really cares about people, there's a warmth" there, **Reule** said.
