

1969 and '70 James Kemp was pastor. He was succeeded in 1971 by Mr. Jesse Lipham who continued until 1975. In 1977 Mr. Tommy Causey pastored. There was no pastor listed in 1978. In '79 Mr. Lon Roberts; and in 1980 and '81 Mr. Lindsey Blackledge served as pastor.

Mr. Carol Worthington became pastor in 1982 and continues so today.

Mrs. Bartley continued to be recorded as clerk through the mid '70s. Mr. Faircloth was succeeded by William Darby as Sunday School superintendent in 1970 who held that position two years. He was followed by W. E. Cook in '72 and '73 and James Wilson in 1974.

Association messengers were Mrs. Evie Dee Dove and Mr. and Mrs. J. E. Silcox (1969), Mrs. Opal Faircloth, Mrs. Ruth Norris and Mrs. Nancy Bartley (1970), and Mrs. Norris and Mrs. Bartley, again in 1971. In 1972, they were joined by Mrs. Lottie Wilkinson. Mrs. Doris Baker, Mrs. Ruth Baker and Mrs. Katie Dennis (1973), Rev. Jesse Lipham, Mrs. Dewitt Dove, Mrs. Ernest Bartley and Mrs. Dennis (1974) and Mrs. Bartley and Mrs. Dennis were joined by Mrs. Annette Hassebrock and Mrs. Opal Faircloth in 1975.

Mr. Herman Hassebrock continued to be listed as chairman of deacons through 1981 when he was succeeded by Fernie C. Faircloth.

Deceased members include: Mrs. Maggie Albritton (1969), Mrs. Sally Gremling (1970), Mr. Leon Dove (1972), Mr. Sidney Jarvis (1974), and Mr. Talton Byrd (1975).

Church improvements show that the stained glass window was installed in 1970 and the vestibule and a front porch were added to the church.

Whereas church value in 1971 was listed at \$12,000, property — which included the pastor's home was valued at \$47,000 in 1972, and \$70,000 in 1974. Value remained constant in the 1983 assessment.

In 1977, With Mr. Causey as pastor, there were 196 members. Mrs. Annette Hassebrock was superintendent of Sunday School, Nancy Bartley, clerk, and Opal Faircloth, treasurer. Bobby Nall was Training Union director, Mrs. Mimie Causey headed the W.M.U. and Thomas Bethea, music director.

Deaths recorded that year were Mrs. Alma Beck and Mrs. Arnie Baker. Mrs. Ruby Ziglar died in 1978.

1978 minutes show membership of 134. Messengers were the Mrs. Hassebrock, Dennis and Bartley.

In 1979, Mr. Roberts was pastor and Clif Mitchum is recorded as Sunday School superintendent, Nancy Bartley, Training Union director. Membership was listed at 182.

There were 167 members in 1980 and '81, 164 in 1982, 161 in 1983.

Members who died included Mrs. Rudolph Peadin (1980), Mrs. Lottie Tennent (1981), and Mrs. Ruth Baker, Mr. Archie Bryars, and Mrs. Cleo Tennent (1983).

There are currently 169 members recorded for 1984. Clerk is Opal Faircloth, Sunday School Superintendent is Herman Hassebrock. Jean Worthington directs W.M.U. and Nancy Bartley the Training Union.

Fifty-five members are enrolled in Sunday School, 8 in W.M.U. and 21 in the Training Union.
