RICHMOND — The Rev. and Mrs. Daniel H. Rupp were among 17 missionaries appointed at a recent meeting here of the Southern Baptist Foreign Mission Board. They will be assigned to general evangelism work in Colombia.

They are currently living in Osprey, where he is pastor of First Baptist Church.

Born in Indianapolis, Ind., Rupp lived in Paragon, Ind., until third grade when his family moved to El Paso, Tex. He received the bachelor of arts degree in religion from

Wayland Baptist College, Plainview, Tex., and the master of divinity degree from Southwestern Baptist Theological Seminary, Fort Worth, Tex.
