**Segrest, Clark** (1916-1967) was the son of Jessie Joseph and Lula Viola Collins Segrest. He served as pastor of Fort Dade Baptist Church, Dade City and Istachatta Baptist Church. Segrest and his wife, Emma Crew Barthelemey Segrest had three children.

**THE REV. CLARK SEGREEST**, 50, Bushnell, died Tuesday.

He was a lifelong resident of Sumter County and was pastor of Istachatta Baptist Church until he was forced into inactivity by illness. He also was pastor of a number of other churches in the area and was a veteran of World War II.
