Rev. George F. Serson of Fort Worth, pastor of Oak Valley Baptist Church in Bebe, Gonzales County, has accepted a position as minister of a church in Holdcroft, Va.

He will take his new assignment Jan. 1.

Rev. Mr. Serson, a 1953 graduate of Southwestern Baptist Theological Seminary in Fort Worth, organized the Bebe church in June 1952. He commuted 520 miles twice monthly to preach there.
