SHEETZ - Reverend Edward P. Sheetz, 83, went to be with Jesus February 20, 1991. A native of Bridgeport, WV., he had lived in the Jacksonville/Middleburg area for the past 58 years. He was the associate pastor of the Brannenfield Baptist Church, Middleburg, FL. and the former pastor of the Highlands Baptist Church of Highlands, FL. He was well known for his work with the Black Creek Baptist Association and was instrumental in starting many churches in Jacksonville and Middleburg. He was preceded in death by his wife, Nancy Sheetz who passed away January 12, 1988 and is survived by 2 sons, J.E. "Jimmie" Sheetz, Sr. and F.H. "Eric" Sheetz; 3 daughters, Joan Anderson, Donna Kilpatrick and Rosemary Sanders; sister, Jackie Deaux; 10 grandchildren; 11 great-grandchildren. Funeral services will be held at 11 a.m. SATURDAY at the HARDAGE - GIDDENS FUNERAL HOME, 729 S. Edgewood Ave. with Dr. Ray Dobbins, Dr. George Mikell and Rev. Ron Rowe, officiating.
