## Rev. Sims Resigns Church Pastorate

BOYNTON BEACH—The resignation of the Rev. Harvey L. Sims, pastor of the Boynton Beach Baptist Church for more than two years, was read and accepted Wednesday evening at a board meeting in the Church. The resignation is effective August 9 and he will preach his farewell sermon at the evening service at 8 p. m. .

Mr. Sims with his wife and son, Harold, come to Boynton Beach in May 1940 and during his stay here has made an outstanding record for the church. The parsonage was built since he came here, Sunday school rooms completed, electric ceiling fans installed, cabinets built and many other minor improvements made to the church. He will leave the local church in the best financial condition that it has ever enjoyed, all bills are paid and money in the treasury.

At the present Mr. Sims is working for an electrical company in West Palm Beach, where he plans to move his family.
