54 Baptist churches reported a membership of 23,285 and a Sunday School enrollment of 19,491.

Those 50 reporting churches also tallied 1,572 new members last year by baptism and 2,212 by letter.

Those churches also reported receipts of \$1,349,931.19 with contributions of \$211,085 to missions.
