He graduated from the Baptist Bible Institute, Graceville, 1967. Sims served as pastor of churches in Alabama and Florida including Southside Baptist Church, Longwood and Fairview Shores Baptist Church, Orlando. He and his wife, Margaret Stafford Sims had three children.
