Rev. Stallings Will Take Over New Pastorate

The Rev. Dwight W. Stallings recently called to the Hogan Baptist Church, will begin his ministry at the church and conduct services Sunday.

Rev. Mr. Stallings was ordained to the ministry by the Grant Park Baptist Church, Atlanta, Ga. He resigned his pastorate with the Inman Yards Baptist Church of Atlanta to take up work in Jacksonville.

Since coming here Mr. Stallings served as educational director of the Beverly Hills Baptist Church, later being appointed pastor of a mission sponsored by that church. Under his leadership, it was stated, this newly organized church has been donated a lot on which to erect a church building and adequate funds have been raised for the completion of the edifice.

The Rev. Mr. Stallings has been supplying at Hogan for some time, it was stated, and will begin his ministry tomorrow. He comes to Hogan only a few months after the completion of a large addition to the church building. Services during the past months have increased and the Sunday School department is showing a large increase, it was announced.

Hogan Baptist Schedule Set

Pending the appointment of a permanent pastor, to take the place of the Rev. Dwight W. Stallings, whose resignation became effective a week ago, guest speakers will conduct Sunday services at the Hogan Baptist Church, it was announced yesterday.

The Rev. J. Leslie Batchelder, a well known missionary, will deliver the sermons at 11 A. M. and 8 P. M. tomorrow, according to Mrs. V. D. Davenport, church secretary. The night service will include a solo by Miss Bernice Hickman.

Rev. Mr. Stallings is leaving Hogan, a full time charge, to enter mission work among a group of small churches, the secretary said. A pulpit committee, to pick his successor, will be named next week.
