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Stamey, Henry W. (1920-2002) was born in Athens, Tennessee. He graduated from Tennessee Wesleyan College, Carson-Newman College and New Orleans Baptist Theological Seminary. Stamey served as a Southern Baptist evangelist participating in over 200 revival meetings and campaigns. He served as pastor of churches in Tennessee and Florida including Eden Baptist Church, Brooksville, First Baptist Church, Osteen, First Baptist Church, Southport, First Baptist Church, Seffner, and Peace Creek Baptist Church, Bartow. Stamey and his wife, Ann Campbell Stamey had three children.



The **Rev. Henry W. Stamey**, Southern Baptist evangelist, will conduct a revival at the McCarty Baptist Church on North Tunnel Boulevard Sunday through May 18, with services each evening at 7:30, it is announced by the host minister, the **Rev. Coy A. Riddle**. Music will be led by E. H. LaFerry.

A graduate of Carson-Newman College and New Orleans Baptist Theological Seminary, the **Rev. Mr. Stamey** is a World War II veteran who lost a leg while in service.

With his wife and two children the **Stameys** reside at 1018 Lansdell Rd. in Chattanooga.

Lakeland—Reverend Henry W. Stamey, of Lakeland died Friday (Jan. 4, 2002) at Bartow Memorial Hospital. He was 81.

Born in Athens, TN on June 22, 1920, he came to Lakeland from Osteen, FL 27 years ago. He was a Southern Baptist minister for 47 years, pastoring Peace Creek Baptist Church. He received his A.A. Degree from Tenn. Wesleyan, in Athens, TN, his B.S. Degree from Carson Newman College in Jefferson City, TN, and his Masters Degree from New Orleans Baptist Theological Seminary, New Orleans, LA. He was a member of VFW Post #2405 of Bartow. He was also a decorated World War II Army veteran.

He is survived by his wife, Anne Stamey; daughter, Jane S. Adkins and son-in-law, Royce Adkins, of Lakeland; daughter, Ruth Ann Aulds, of Cleveland, TN; son, Lewis D. Stamey, and daughter-in-law, Pamela F. Stamey, of Valrico, FL; sisters, Blanche Queen, and Irene Brock, both of Athens, TN; and grandchildren, Amanda Seger and Marc Segar of Bartow, FL,

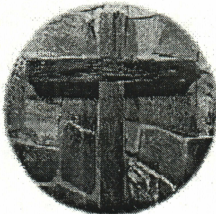
